

Marking Degree Measurements on the Jumbo Circle Template

Manufacturing Dots

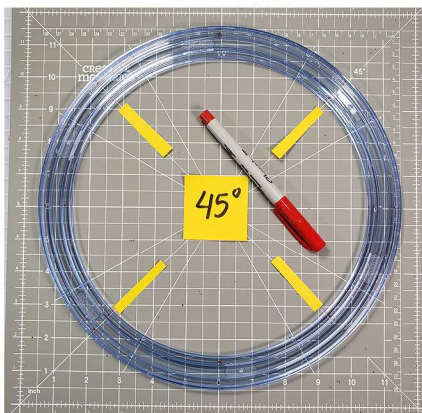
There are manufacturing "dots" on the CCS templates. On the Jumbo Circle template these dots are spaced every 15 degrees and we can use these spacing to accurately mark the template.



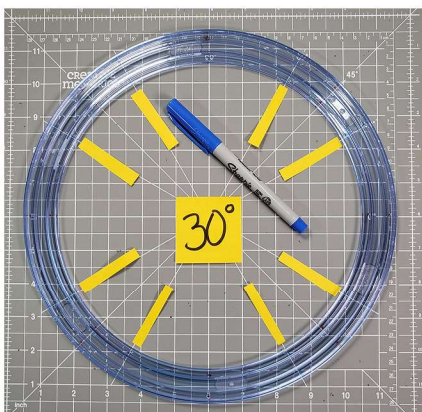
1. Locate one of these manufacturing dots and mark it with a **BLACK FINE TIP Sharpie**.

2. After marking the dot, place the template on the 13x13 mat with the dot in the 12 o'clock position

3. Proceed to use the 13x13 mat to help you find the dots at the 90° increments. These equate to 12, 3, 6 and 9 o'clock on a clock face. Use a **BLACK sharpie** to mark these dots.



4. Use a **RED FINE TIP sharpie** to mark the dots at the 45° increments. These will line up with the corners of the 13x13 mat.



5. Use a **BLUE FINE TIP sharpie** to mark the dots that are at 30 degree increments as shown in photo. These correspond with 1, 2, 4, 5, 7, 8, 10 and 11 o'clock on a clock face. (12, 3, 6 and 9 were marked in step 3 as part of the 90° increments)
