

CM Blog Borders

Scrapbook Live with Meggan - September 28, 2022

Sample border and blog directions use the Winter Woods collection.

Step 1: Cut a $3-1/4 \times 12^{\circ}$ strip of green plaid patterned paper for the base. Cut a $2-3/4 \times 11-1/2^{\circ}$ strip of White Solid Cardstock and mount it on the base.

Step 2: Punch a border with the Treeline Border Punch with Dark Green Solid Cardstoc. Trim to measure $12 \times 3-3/4$ ". Cut into 2-1/2"-wide sections. Repeat with snowflake paper, varying the sections so the trees offset the green ones.

Step 3: Punch a tree border with snowy pines patterned paper. Trim to measure $12 \times 4-1/2$ ". Cut into 2-1/2"-wide sections. Using the 12-inch Decorative Trimmer, cut the sections apart.

Step 4: Adhere the tree line sections to the white strip, starting with dark green on top, then snowflake, then the snowy pines sections, using the photo as a guide. Trim the last layers as needed to fit the strip.

Step 5: Add stickers, mounting some with Foam Squares for added dimension.

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Step 1: Using the 12-inch Trimmer with the Victorian blade, cut a $3-1/4 \times 12$ " strip of salmon pink designer paper for the base.

Step 2: With the 12-inch Trimmer with the Straight Blade, cut a $2-3/4 \times 12^{\circ}$ strip of olive green paper and adhere to the base. Cut a $2-5/8 \times 12^{\circ}$ strip of white dainty floral designer paper and mount on top.

Step 3: Punch a border using the Mandala Burst Border Punch with dark teal dotted designer paper. Trim to measure 12 x 3" and punch the other side. Using the inside of the medium Custom Cutting System Circle Pattern [Circle #2] and the Blue Blade, cut five circles from gold tonal paper. Adhere behind each of the circular bursts. Mount on the border.

Step 4: Add stickers, popping some up with foam squares for added dimension.
