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Sample layout and blog directions use the Polar Lights collection.

- Step 1: Use a piece of Navy Solid Cardstock as the base.
- **Step 2:** Cut a [second] piece of Navy Solid Cardstock to measure 11-3/4 x 11-3/4" and cut out a 2"-wide frame. Set aside the square piece.
- **Step 3**: Cut four 4 x 12" strips of various designer papers. Cut each strip as shown [photo above.]
- **Step 4:** Adhere the strips to the navy frame, spacing 1/8" each other as shown. Trim the excess. Add to the navy cardstock base.
- **Step 5**: Cut a 7-1/2 \times 7-1/2" square from the herringbone designer paper and adhere to the page.
- **Step 6**: Use the Polar Bears Border Punch to punch a border from the navy square piece that you cut in Step 2. Add to the page.
- **Step 7**: Cut one 3-9/16 x 6-1/8" mat and two 3-9/16" x 3" mats from the square navy remnant made in Step 2.
- **Step 8:** Adhere flocked borders, stickers, embellishments and mats, using Foam Squares on some for added dimension.
