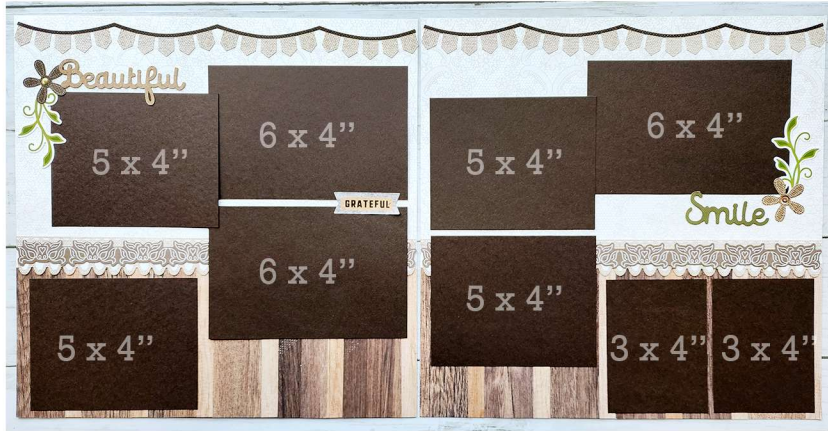




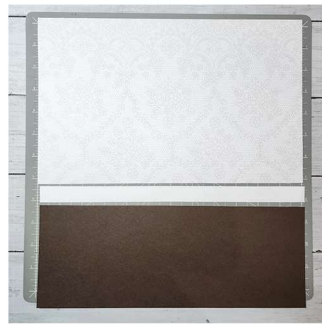
Burlap & Lace - Layout 2



SUPPLIES

- 2 White Lace Paper
- 2 Wood Paper Remnants
- 2 Burlap Laser Cut Borders
- 2 Brown Scroll Laser Cut Borders
- Cardstock for Paper Welding

1. Trim both pieces of White Lace paper at 7-1/2". Save the smaller pieces for another layout.

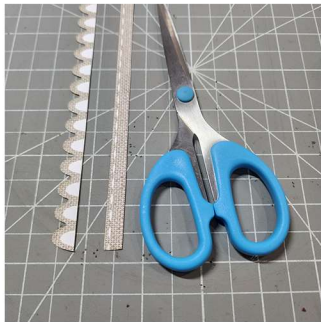


2. Trim 2 pieces of cardstock (any color) to 4-1/2 x 12" and paper weld to the bottom of both white lace papers.



3. Trim the 4-1/2 x 12" wood paper at 1-1/2", and then at 1/2". Repeat the cutting pattern across both 12" lengths of paper.

4. Adhere the wood "planks" on the cardstock section at the bottom of each page. Start with the 1-1/2" width piece, dark side up. Adhere the 1/2" piece next to it, light side up. Repeat to create a wood panel effect on the bottom of the pages.



5. Trim both burlap borders in half where the white loop meets the burlap.



6. Adhere the scallop edge to the bottom of the brown scroll border and the straight burlap piece at the top.

FINISHING THE LAYOUT

Adhere the border across the top edge of the wood panel bottom so that it just barely overlaps the panels.

Adhere the burlap banner border stickers across the top of each page.

Mats in sample are made with Hot Fudge Cardstock.
