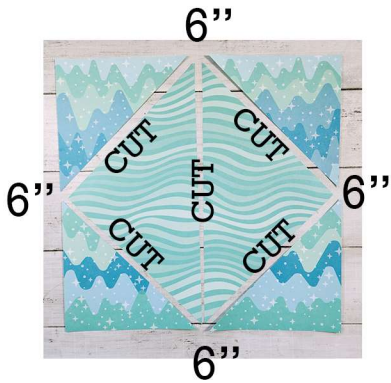
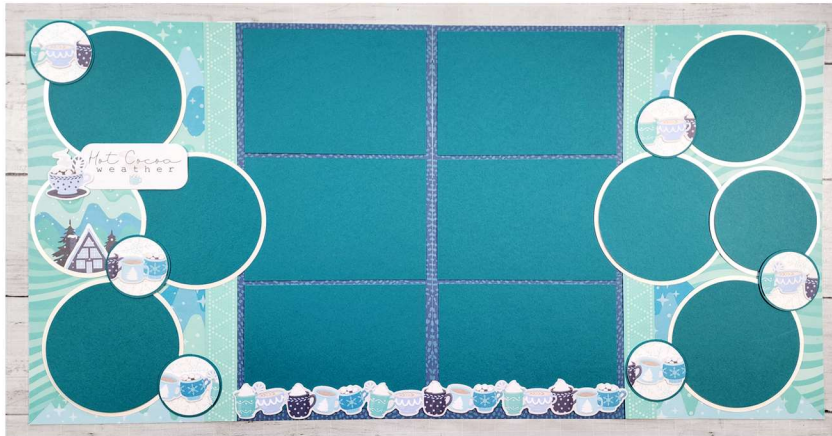




Polar Lights - Layout 2

SUPPLIES

- 1 Aurora Borealis Paper
- 1 Tonal Blue Paper or Cardstock
- 2 Mint Borders from Border Paper
- White Shimmer Paper or Cardstock
- 2 Mug Borders
- Circles CCS + Blades
- Circle Punch (optional)



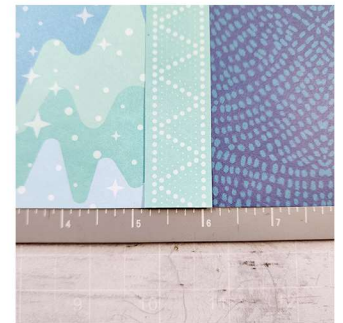
1. Trim the designer paper in half at 6" and then cut each half into triangles by cutting from the 6" on the long edge to the corner of the opposite side. (see photo)



2. Trim the white cover-sheet in half to 6 x 12" and adhere the pieces as shown to make 6 x 12" segments.



3. Trim a tonal blue paper or cardstock in half at 6" and paper weld the pieces as shown to make (2) 12 x 12" backgrounds.



4. Trim the mint borders from the border paper and adhere over the seam. Leave as much of the blue paper showing as possible.



5. Use the Circle Punch to make 6 circles from the white/blue snowflake mat. Punch 6 segments from 1 of the mug borders and adhere to circles.

Alternate - use Circle #2, blue blade, inside track



6. Use Circle #2 with the blue blade on the inside track to cut 6 circles to mat the mug embellishments.

Alternate: use Circle #2, green blade, inside track

FINISHING THE LAYOUT

Use Circle #1 with the green blade on the outside track to make 6 circles from White Shimmer Paper. Use as mats for photos cut with Circle #1, red blade, outside track.

Use Circle #3 with the green blade on the inside track to cut two mats with White Shimmer Paper. Use with the Circle Cabin Embellishment or cut photos with Circle #3, blue blade, inside track.

Horizontal photos are 5-1/2 x 3-3/4"
