Step 1: Cut a piece of mustard floral tonal paper to measure 12 x 3-1/4". Use this as the base of the border.

Step 2: Cut a piece of green dotted triangles tonal paper to measure 12 x 3". Adhere to the middle of the border.

Step 3: Cut a piece of tangerine geometric weave designer paper to measure 12 x 2-1/2".

Step 4: Using the Monstera Leaves Border Punch, punch three borders from desired papers. Adhere to the top of the tangerine paper, slightly overlapped. Place each of the ends along the 45-degree line on the 12-inch Trimmer, with the point on the cutting line, and cut. Place these two pieces in the lower-right and upper-left piece of the dark green paper, leaving about 1/4" border around them. With the remaining inside piece, cut at 1-1/4" segments along the 45-degree line. Space accordingly between the corner pieces.

Step 5: Using the inside edge of the smallest CCS Circle Pattern and the Red Blade, cut a circle from navy lined stripes tonal paper.

Step 6: Using the inside edge of the largest CCS Circle Pattern and the Blue Blade, cut a circle from mustard floral tonal paper.

Step 7: Layer the circles together, then adhere to the border.

Step 8: Adhere stickers, using Foam Squares for added dimension.

Step 1: Cut a 12 x 2-1/4" strip of tropical floral designer paper for the base. Cut an 11-1/2 x 1-3/4" strip of navy tonal paper and align and adhere it to the middle of the base. Cut an 11-1/4 x 1-1/2" strip of tan canvas designer paper and mount on top.

Step 2: Using the Mirrored Triangles Border Maker Cartridge, punch one border from each olive, dark teal stripe and terra cotta papers. Using just the punched out pieces of the dark teal border (save the actual border for one of the following borders), adhere them behind the terra cotta border so the dark teal shows through the triangle cutouts. Trim off the middle bar section of the olive border so just the two zigzag sections remain. Attach each to the top and bottom of the terra cotta border, trimming as necessary, and mount on the border.

Step 3: Add embellishments and stickers, popping some up with Foam Squares for added dimension.

Step 1: Cut a piece of White Cardstock to measure 12 x 1-3/4".

Step 2: Cut five pieces of paper from various shades to measure 2-7/16 x 1-1/2". Adhere to the border.

Step 3: Using the Seashells Border Punch, punch a border from White Cardstock. Adhere to the border.

Step 4: Using the Seashells Border Punch with the five shades of previously used paper, punch one section of "punch" from each color. Adhere to the top of the White Cardstock border using Foam Squares. Vary the shades that are on top of each other.
