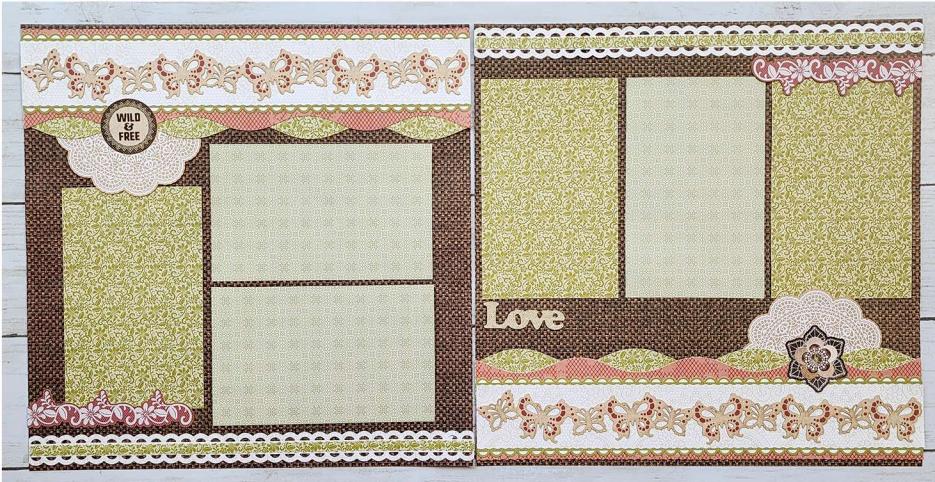


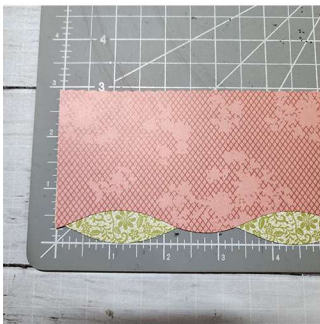


Burlap & Lace - Layout 4



SUPPLIES

- 2 Brown Burlap Papers
- 1 Rose Lace Paper Remnant
- 1 Green Paper + Remnant
- 1 White Paper Remnant
- 12" Decorative Trimmer
- Butterfly Laser Cut Borders
- 2 Green Mirrored Scallop Stickers
- Mirrored Scallop BMC



DIRECTIONS

1. Feed the rose paper in from the right side of the Deco Trimmer. Trim a small strip to establish the wave edge. Use the rotary trimmer with the wave blade and cut at 2-3/4". Repeat to make a second rose lace border.

2. Feed the green paper in from the left side of the Deco Trimmer. Trim a small strip to establish a wave edge. Use the rotary trimmer and cut at 1". Repeat to make a second green border.

3. Layer the green border behind the rose border so that the peaks of the green border show (see photo at left.)

4. Trim (2) 1-3/4" strips of white lace paper with the rotary trimmer + wave blade. Adhere the butterfly laser cut borders to the white strips.

5. Cut each of the green mirrored scallop stickers in half (use scissors for better precision - cuts don't have to be perfect.) Be sure to leave the stickers on the backing strip when cutting.

6. Use repo adhesive on the very edge of the backside of the white lace strips. Adhere the strips to the green sticker segments (See photos.) Then adhere to the rose borders.

7. Punch two Mirrored Scallop Borders from the white lace paper. Cut (2) 1/4" strips of green paper with the rotary trimmer + wave blade and adhere to center of borders. Adhere to the layout as shown.

8. Cut (6) 3-3/4 x 6" mats from the remaining piece of green tonal paper. Use as mats for 3-1/2 x 5-3/4" photos.

9. Add embellishments as desired.
