



Meggan Jacks Scrapbooking

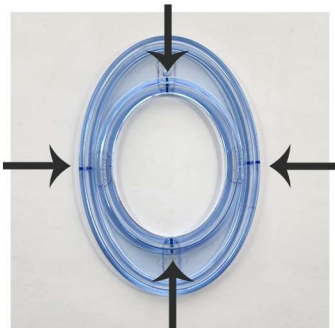
ALL ACCESS PROJECT



1. Trim (4) thin 3/16" strips from one side of a 12 x 12" paper. Then trim 4 more strips from the shorter side.



2. Cut four 5-1/2" squares from remnant.



3. Use a Sharpie to mark the center of each side of Oval #4 (largest oval.)



4. Center a square on the cutting mat and center Oval #4 on the square. Use the blue blade on outside track to cut the sides.



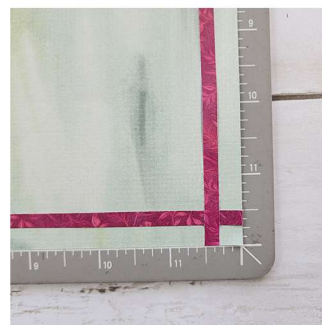
5. Keep the paper in place and rotate the oval. Make sure the oval is centered and cut the top and bottom of the square.



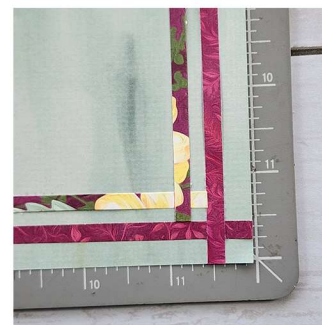
6. Repeat Steps 4 and 5 on the three remaining squares.



7. Use the scoring blade or multi-purpose tool to score from corner to corner of the inside edges as shown above. Fold edges.



8 Adhere the 4 longer strips from Step 1 about 1/2" from the outside edge of the paper.



9 Adhere the 4 shorter strips to the inside of the longer strips. Cut ends so they fit.



10. Adhere the folded shapes so they meet in the middle of the page.
