



Sample layout and blog directions use the Riveting (2024) collection.

Step 1: Use lumber paper as the base for the layout.

Step 2: Adhere the caution tape border sticker along the top edge of the layout.

Step 3: Cut a piece of crinkled paper to measure 12" x 1/2". Adhere just under the border sticker.

Step 4: Cut a piece of Blue Solid Cardstock to measure 12" x 3".

Step 5: Cut 15 pieces of a variety of patterns of paper to measure 3/4" x 2-3/4". Place each piece along the 45-degree line on the 12-inch Trimmer with the upper-right corner touching the 1/8" line to the right of the cut line (see original blog post for details). Then cut. Flip the piece of paper over, then repeat this step. This gives the corners the look that emulates the top of the fence posts.

Step 6: Adhere each strip to the bottom edge of the Blue Solid Cardstock strip using Foam Tape.

Step 7: Tear two pieces of green plaid paper that measure 12" x 3/4". Layer and place on the bottom edge of the fence posts.

Step 8: Cut 4 photo mats from blueprint paper that measure 5-3/4" x 3-3/4". Adhere to the layout.

Step 9: Adhere 4 photos that measure 5-1/2" x 3-1/2" to the mats.

Step 10: Adhere stickers to the layout, using Foam Squares on some for dimension.

Step 11: Journal as desired.

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
