



Border #1

Tools:
Bear Chain BMC
Mirrored Scallops BMC
12" Trimmer with Scallop Blade

Step 1: Punch one 12" border from navy cardstock with the Bears Chain BMC. Punch a second border from navy cardstock with the Mirrored Scallops BMC. Cut the Mirrored Scallops BMC in half lengthwise.

Step 2: Cut the yellow strip paper at 2-1/4" and the dark teal sparkle paper at 1-5/8".

Step 3: Use the rounded side of the scallop blade to cut the dotted stripe paper at 1-3/8".

Step 4: Assemble the border, layering as shown.



Border #2

Tools:
Bear Chain BMC
12" Trimmer with Wave Blade

Step 1: Punch two 12" borders from contrasting cardstock using the Bears BMC.

Step 2: Trim two 1-1/8 x 12" strips of tonal paper to complement the cardstock bear border.

Step 3: Adhere the bear border strips on top of the paper strips from Step 2.

Step 4: Cut each strip into 2" lengths.

Step 5: Cut two strips, 1-3/8 x 12" each, from contrasting cardstock with the wave blade. Adhere 2" border segments to each strip. This will make two borders.

Step 6: Trim 2 1-5/8 x 12" strips of designer paper and adhere a wave border pieces on top of each as shown in sample.



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Border #3

Tools:
Bear Chain BMC

Step 1: Cut a piece of cardstock or paper into two 12 x 6". Mark the each piece on the BACK at the following increments

10-3/4" 8-3/8" 6" 3-5/8" 1-1/4"

Step 2: Center the Bears BMC at 6 inches and punch. Be sure to insert paper all the way into the punch. Punch at all pencil marks.

Step 3: Cut a complementary paper into two 12 x 6" segments. This becomes the top half of the layout.

Step 4: Cut two 12 x 2" strips of paper that contrast with the punched cardstock pieces. Adhere these strips to the bottom of the pieces from Step 3. They should overlap by 1/4".

Step 5: Adhere the punched cardstock pieces so they create a 12 x 12" background page.

Step 6: Adhere additional designer paper if desired or trim mats for photos.
