



I am Grateful, Too Layout 1



SUPPLIES

- 1 Light Blue/Yellow Stripe
- 1 Jade Leaf/Coral Stripe
- 1 Dark Blue/Multi-Dot
- 1 Notebook/Multi Stripe
- Grid Patterned Vellum
- Canary Cardstock
- Chevron Arrows BMC
- Tearing Tool

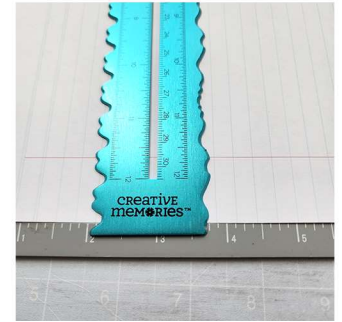


2. Paper weld three pieces together the make a 12 x 12" base page. Repeat to make a second 12 x 12" page.

You should have one 4" strip of each color remaining.



3. From the coral remnant, punch 2 Chevron Arrow borders and trim each to 1-1/8". Cut (2) 1-3/8 x 12" strips from the yellow stripe. Adhere chevron border to yellow stripe strips.



4. Use a tearing tool or decorative blade on the trimmer to cut the notebook paper 3-3/4" from the top and from the bottom.

1. Trim each sheet shown above into (3) 4 x 12" strips. When trimming the jade leaf, make sure coral stripes are going horizontal.

DO NOT CUT THE NOTEBOOK PAPER



5. On left page, adhere the top strip of the notebook paper 1/4" from the top. On right page, adhere notebook paper 1/4" from bottom. Angle border across both pieces as shown in sample.

MATS & PHOTOS

From Canary cardstock, cut a piece 7-1/2 x 12". Rotate piece 90° and trim at 5-1/2" two times to create two mats 7-1/2 x 5-1/2". Use with 3-1/2 x 5" photos.

From remaining strip of cardstock, cut two circle mats using Circle #1. Use the red blade on the outside track for the right page and use the blue blade on the outside track for the left page. Left page photo cut with Circle #3, red blade inside track. Right page cut photos with Circle #1 and red blade on outside track.

From the Grid vellum paper, cut a strip 4-1/2 x 12". Rotate strip 90° and trim at 6-1/2" to make two mats. Use the larger mat on the left page with a 4 x 6" photo and the smaller mat on the right page with a 4 x 5" photo.

EMBELLISHMENTS

Use the Embossed Blossom punch to punch two blossoms from the Canary cardstock. Layer behind the laser cut embellishment as shown.
