

Punching in the Round



Jumbo Circle + CM Punches

The chart below should be used as a starting point. Depending on the punch, you may need to alter the blade choice. Practice all cuts before punching on your favorite paper. Use chart on next page to write down your successful pairings for future use.

Punch Style	Track	Blade	Angle	Notes
Border Punch (Not Frame Style)	Outside	Red	30°	Line up center of punch with marking on paper. If punches are too close together, move up to green or blue blade.
Border Punch (Not Frame Style)	Inside	Blue	45°	Punch on marks. Start with blue to test pattern. If you need to go a little larger, move up to green or red. Space between punches will get larger as you move from blue up to red when working with the inside track.
Frame Punch	Outside	Blue	45°	Punch at 45° marks and then punch in between each to complete circle.
Border Maker Cartridge	Outside	Blue	45°	Punch at 45° markings and then punch in between to complete circle.
Border Maker Cartridge	Inside	Red	30°	Punch at marks, hugging the outside edge
Border Maker Cartridge	Outside	Blue	45°	Punch at 45° markings and then punch in between to complete circle.
Circle Punch	Outside	Blue	45°	I recommend watching the video on this technique as it is difficult to describe in such a small box. Video link: https://youtu.be/E2pgee-Y8uc
Decorative Punches	Outside	Varies	30° (varies)	Blade and angle will vary depending on size of punch you are using and spacing you desire. Using the angle lines will help you with even spacing of the punches.
