


ALL ACCESS PROJECT

Cut & Score Corner Borders





Start with 6x6 square piece of designer paper.

- 1. BLACK LINE STRAIGHT BLADE Trim 6x6" square in half diagonally to create two triangles.
- **2. RED LINES DECORATIVE BLADE** Feed one triangle into trimmer. Line up LONGEST SIDE at 1.75 inches and trim with decorative blade of choice.
- 3. BLUE LINES SCORING BLADE use scoring blade to create fold line 0.5" from the decorative edge of each piece. Fold back decorative edge on each piece.



Page Assembly

- 1. Adhere smaller triangle in corner approximately 1/8" from edge on both sides.
- 2. Use a border of your choice to help space the second, larger section of the triangle.
- 3. Repeat in opposite corner.

Use a second 6x6 square to make another pair of corner borders for a 2 page layout. You can also experiment with different sizes of squares.
