



## Border 1

**Step 1:** Cut a 3 x 12" strip with Navy Solid Cardstock for the base. Cut a 2-3/4 x 11-3/4" strip with diagonal stripes paper and adhere on the base. Cut a 2-1/4 x 11-1/4" strip with arrows paper and mount on top.

**Step 2:** Cut five 2" squares with stamps paper. Round the corners using the 2-Way Corner Rounder. Adhere on the arrows strip.

**Step 3:** Using the Circle Punch, punch a circle with each map, compass, arrows, geo and waves papers. Adhere on the squares.

**Step 4:** Using the Compass Punch, punch five shapes with Navy Solid Cardstock. Using the inside edge of the small Custom Cutting System Circle Pattern and the Blue Blade, cut five circles with White Solid Cardstock. Adhere behind the compass shapes and mount on the border using Foam Squares.

**Step 5:** Top each compass with a coordinating compass sticker.

## Border 2



Sample border and blog directions use the Summer Break (2024) collection.

**Step 1:** Cut a 12 x 3" strip with strokes paper for the base. Cut a 12 x 2-1/2" strip with dots paper and adhere on the base. Cut six 2" squares with cool tonal colorblock, good times and ice cream cone papers. Adhere on the border as shown.

**Step 2:** Using the Kite Build-A-Punch, punch shapes with a variety of designer papers. Build kites on each of the squares, filling in with different colors as desired. Draw kite strings and adhere the bows.

**Step 3:** Adhere stickers using Foam Squares.

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## Border 3

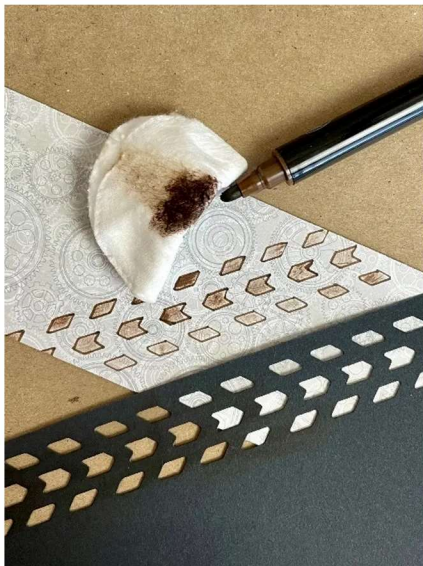
Sample border and blog directions use the Revved Up! (2024) collection.

**Step 1:** Cut a piece of Black Cardstock to measure 12" x 2-3/4" for the base of the border.

**Step 2:** Cut a piece of layered gears paper to measure 12" x 2-1/2". Use the Brown Dual Tip Pen and run it on the makeup sponge. Then rub the makeup sponge along the top edges this piece of paper to grunge it up.

**Step 3:** Using a piece of cardstock, punch along the edge using the Tire Tracks BMC in the Border Maker System. Use this as the template for the tire tracks.

**Step 4:** Lay the tire tracks template at an angle on the layered gears paper strip, then run the bold tip of the pen on the makeup sponge, then over the top of the tire track template. Before lifting the template, use the fine point of the pen to trace along the inside areas of the template. Repeat this angled tire tracks three times.



**Step 5:** Cut a piece of tracks paper to measure 12" x 1/3". Adhere between the tire tracks, cutting with scissors along the edges of the layered gears paper.

**Step 6:** Cut two pieces from the tire crosshatch paper to measure 5-1/4" x 3/4" and 2-1/4" x 3/4". Cut a "v" into one end of the paper strips, then cut the other end at a 45-degree angle on the trimmer. Adhere to the border.

**Step 7:** Cut two pieces from the vehicle parts paper to measure 4-1/4" x 1/3" and 1" x 1/3". Cut a "v" into one end of the paper strips, then cut the other end at a 45-degree angle on the trimmer. Adhere to the border.

**Step 8:** Adhere this layered gears strip to the top of the black cardstock base.

**Step 9:** Adhere the stickers and embellishments using Foam Squares for added dimension.

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
