



Striped Corners Layout

SUPPLIES

- Fur Baby Papers
- Hot Fudge Cardstock
- Fur Baby Variety Mats
- Laser Cut Borders/Border Elements
- Handheld Rotary Trimmer
- 18" Ruler



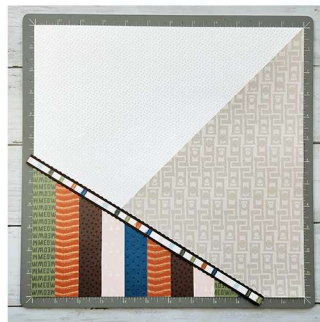
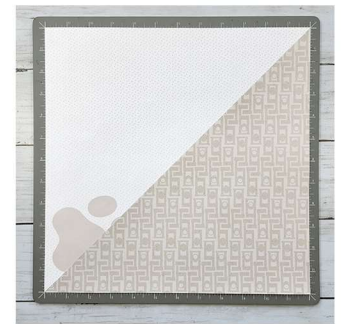
1. Cut a piece of cardstock to 10 x 6" and cover with ten 1 x 6" strips of paper.



2. Cut the rectangle on an angle from upper left to lower right.



3. Trim the tonal cat tree paper on the diagonal. An 18" ruler with rotary cutter works well to cut the diagonal. Flip the upper left piece over and paper weld as shown. Repeat with second paper. The second welded background can be rotated 180° to make the right page.



4. Adhere one triangle to the page as shown. Trim a 1/4" strip of coordinating paper and back with a 1/2" strip of cardstock. Adhere along the upper edge of the triangle.



5. Adhere the second triangle on the left page and create a second decorative band.

6. Adhere two 12" border elements to the bottom left and top right pages as shown.

FINISHING THE LAYOUT:

Use two large variety mats with 6 x 4" photos and/or title mats.

Cut additional mats from cardstock:

(2) 4-3/8" sq mats to use with 4" square photos

(2) 4-3/8 x 6-3/8" mats to use with 4 x 6" photos.
