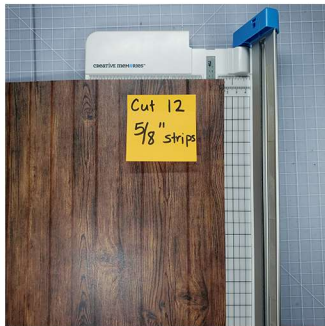

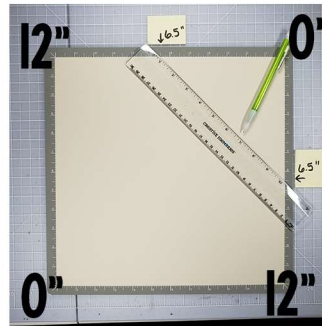
Wood Beam Layout



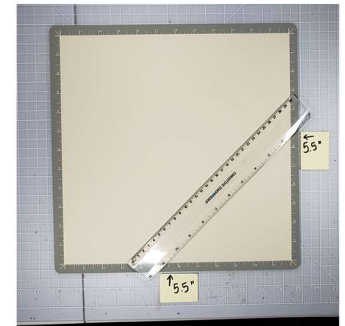
Trim 12 strips of paper to 5/8" wide each.



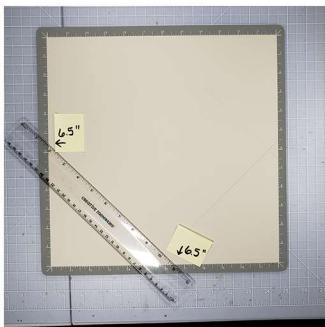
Cut 4 strips in half.



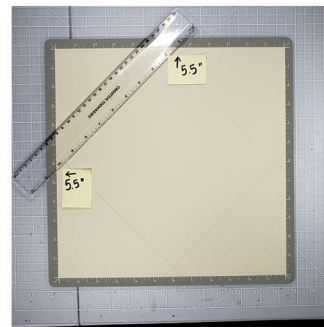
Upper right corner of background page - draw line from 6-1/2 to 6-1/2" as shown.



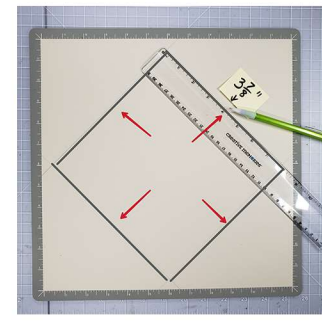
Lower right corner of background page - draw line from 5-1/2 to 5-1/2" as shown.



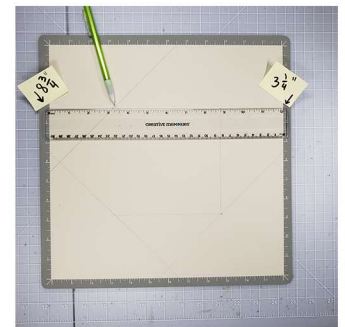
Lower left corner of background page - draw line from 6-1/2 to 6-1/2" as shown.



Upper left corner of background page - draw line from 5-1/2 to 5-1/2" as shown.



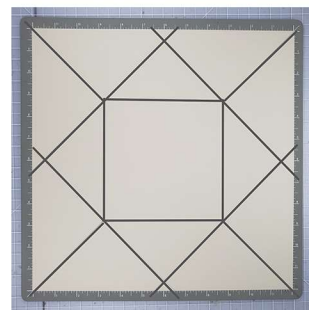
Find the middle of each line (3-7/8") and place a mark.



Use a ruler to connect the marks to form the internal smaller square. (3-1/4" from top of paper)



Draw lines from corners of background paper to the center of the lines drawn in the first 4 steps.



Your final lines should look like this.



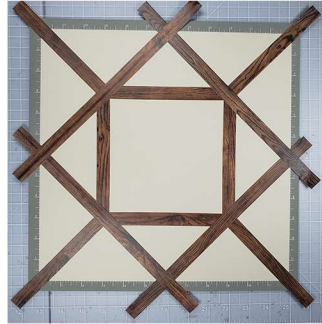

Use the shorter strips to outline the center square first.



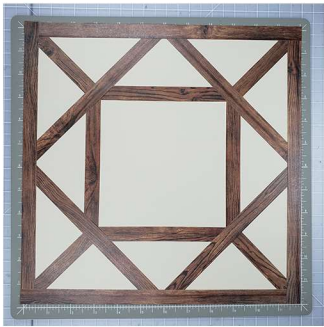
Next, use the remaining shorter strips for the corner beams.



Use four 12" strips to create the larger square.



Use the the final four 12" strips on the outside edge.



Trim any overhanging strips.
