

CM Blog Borders



Good Cat Border

- **Step 1**: Cut a piece of the insert sheet from your paper pack (or scrap paper) to measure 12" x 3". Use this for the base of the border.
- Step 2: Cut two pieces from the houndstooth paper to measure 2" x 3".
- Step 3: Cut two pieces from the pink cat toys paper to measure 2" x 3".
- Step 4: Cut two pieces from the fish bones paper to measure 2" x 3".
- Step 5: Adhere these six pieces to the top of the border base.
- Step 6: Cut a piece of Hot Fudge Solid Cardstock to measure 12" x 2-1/4".
- **Step 7:** Using the Square Punch, punch two squares from each of the following papers: houndstooth, fish bones and pink cat toys. Adhere to the cardstock leaving approximately 1/4" in between each square.
- **Step 8:** Using Hot Fudge Solid Cardstock, punch three pieces from the Feline Dine Punch. Adhere to each of the squares, along the top portion.
- Step 9: Adhere the "good cat" border sticker along the bottom portion of the squares.
- Step 10: Cut a piece from the blue plaid paper to measure 12" x 1/4". Adhere above the border sticker.
- Step 11: Adhere the whole Hot Fudge Solid Cardstock piece to the base of the border using Foam Tape.



Coastal Living Border

- Step 1: Cut a 12° x $3-1/4^{\circ}$ strip with green wash F2F paper for the base. Using the pinking blade, cut a $12 \times 2-3/4^{\circ}$ strip with beige wash paper and adhere on the base.
- **Step 2**: Using the fishnet border punch, punch a border with red cardstock. Adhere on the border 1/2" from the bottom edge. Cut a 12 x 1-1/2" strip with lighthouses & sailboats paper and a 12 x 3/8" strip with nautical stripes paper. Adhere as shown on the border so that one row of the fishnet shows in between.
- Step 3: Adhere stickers, popping some up with foam squares for dimension.

Noel Border

- Step 1: Cut a piece of multi-plaid paper to measure 12" x 2-1/2". Use this as the base of the border.
- **Step 2**: Cut a piece of the holly and pine paper to measure 12" x 3". Using the Linear Plaid BMC with the Border Maker System, punch along one of the 12" edges. Score 1-1/4" from the edge of the side you punched on. Fold on the score line.
- **Step 3**: Cut a piece of Dark Green Solid Cardstock to measure 12" x 1-1/2" using the Colonial Blade on the Trimmer on one edge. Adhere this strip under the folded over piece with the Linear Plaid border. Then adhere the Linear Plaid edge to the top.
- **Step 4**: Adhere a border sticker from the back folded edge of the previous piece, then adhere the whole piece to the bottom edge of the border.
- Step 5: Adhere stickers and embellishments using Foam Squares.
