




### Burlap & Lace - Layout 3



#### SUPPLIES

- 2 Concrete Papers
- 1 Rose Lace Paper
- 1 Green Paper
- 2 Rivet Sticker Borders
- 12" Decorative Trimmer




1. Mark the outside corners of the 2-page layout as shown in the photo at left. Score a line between each corresponding pencil mark.

2. Fold the corners back as shown. Note: I initially started with the darker side of the paper facing forward, so the photo reflects that. Use whichever side of the concrete paper you prefer.

3. Trim a 4 x 12" piece from the green tonal paper. Trim into (3) 4 x 4" squares.

4 Trim (2) of the squares on the diagonal to create four triangles. Adhere one triangle behind each folded corner of the background paper, lighter green side up.



5. Trim the remaining green 4" square into four 2" squares. Trim two of the smaller squares on the diagonal into triangles. Adhere the smaller triangles to each corner as shown, darker side up.

6. Use the 12" Decorative Trimmer to cut (5) 1" strips with the wavy edge. Trim one strip in half at 6". Use the smaller segments on the left and right edges of the layout. Use the 12" strips for the top/bottom of each page, trimming excess.

#### FINISHING THE LAYOUT

Trim the rivet border stickers in half and clean up the cut ends to show a whole rivet. Adhere to layout in each corner as shown.

Photos mats in layout represent 4 x 4" and 5-1/2 x 4" photos.
