

Folded Circle Border





SUPPLIES

- Circle Punch (1-3/4") -or- CCS Circle #2 with Green Blade
- Scoring Blade
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Various designer papers

Sample made with Totally Tonal Fall Plaid (2022)



1. Create 15 circles with double sided paper. There should be contrast between the sides when folded.



2. Line up the left edge of the circle at 1" and score.



3. Fold each circle on the score line.



4. Trim a base border strip to 2-1/4 x 12." Draw a pencil line down the center of the paper (1-1/8").



5. Center the first circle at 6" with the folded edge on the pencil line. Adhere circles as shown.



6. Adhere the second row of circles offsetting the circles to make the pattern.



7. Trim a 2-5/8 x 12" strip of paper as a contrasting base to the border. Adhere the folded flaps down.



8. Add an accent border across the folded seam if desired. Circle Chain shown with a 5/16" strip woven in.

FINISHING THE LAYOUT

Tonal ivory plaid is the base paper. Trim tonal brown plaid to 8 x 12" and mount to base page. Adhere border.

Trim (2) 4×6 " plaid mats (3-5/8 \times 5-5/8" photos) and a 4-1/2 \times 6-1/2" teal plaid mat (4 \times 6" photo.)
