


SUPPLIES

- 2-3 sheets of designer paper
- 2 sheets cardstock or jeeped album pages
- 1-2 sheets of cardstock for mats
- Handheld rotary trimmer
- 18" ruler



BD OF PAPER
B5 KEAPER

Step 1: Choose two matching 12×12 " designer papers and trim a 12×4 " strip from the bottom of each piece*. Use a sticky note to label the larger 12×8 " rectangles A and B.

*If you want to use three different patterns of paper, cut the 12 x 4" rectangles from a separate piece of designer paper.

Step 2: Use a handheld rotary trimmer and an 18" ruler to cut the 12×8 " rectangles into triangles as shown at left.

Step 3: Use two pieces of cardstock or jeeped album pages as your base. Adhere the $12 \times 4^{\circ}$ strips to the bottom of each page.

Step 4: Adhere triangle pieces A1 and B1 directly above the $12 \times 4^{\circ}$ strips. Flip pieces A2 and B2 over to show the reverse pattern and adhere to the page as shown in the sketch.

Step 5: Cut and adhere the title bar, mats and photos as desired. If using 4×6 " mats, trim photos to $5-1/2 \times 3-1/2$ ".
