

Split Border Banner Layout



SUPPLIES

2 Designer Papers

Accent paper or cardstock for banners and mats

Cardstock for additional mats

(1) 12" border element

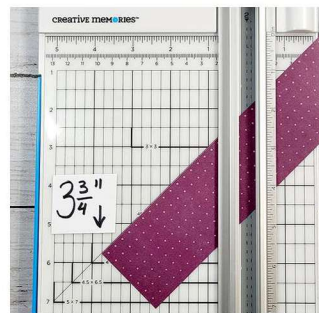
The sample layout uses the Spiced Plum and It's Fall, Y'all! papers.



1. Trim one sheet of tonal orange and decorative leaf paper in half.



2. Paper weld one piece of each paper together to form a 12 x 12" base page. Repeat for second page.



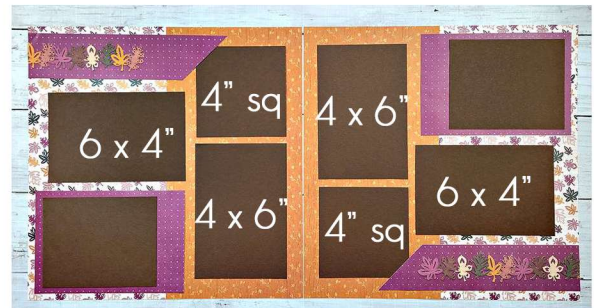
3. Trim (2) 2 x 12" strips of tonal purple paper. Place each strip in trimmer on 45° guide line, placing upper left corner at 3-3/4". Cut to form tapered banner.



4. Trim one 12" leaf border at 7 inches (measured from left.)



5. Attach tapered banners as shown. The left side 7" length of the leafy border goes in the lower right banner. The shorter 5" length goes in the upper left.



6. Trim two 6-1/2 x 4-1/2" mats from the tonal purple paper. Add additional mats as desired or mount photos directly to page.



7. Attach title to the right of the leaves in upper left banner



8. 4 x 5" photos can be placed on the larger photo mats leaving an area to decorate with a border element.
