



SUPPLIES

- Edge Style Border Punch (Flower Pots Border Punch Shown)
- Edge or Chain Style BMC (Watering Cans BMC Shown)
- Cardstock to punch and use for mats
- Various patterns of designer paper
- 2 sheets of paper for base layout



Base Border Strip: 3-1/8 x 12"

Background Strip A: 2-3/4 x 12"

Background Strip B: 2-3/8 x 12"

Accent Strip C: 1 x 12"

Accent Strip D: 1 x 12"



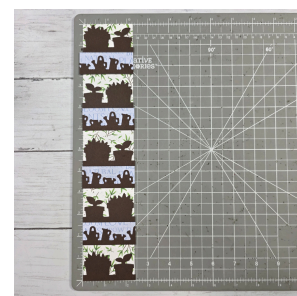
Punch cardstock with the border punch and trim to 1-3/8" tall and then cut into five 2-3/8" segments. Punch a 12" BMC border from cardstock and trim to 7/8" tall.



Adhere the BMC border strip to Accent Strip D and trim into four 2-3/8" segments



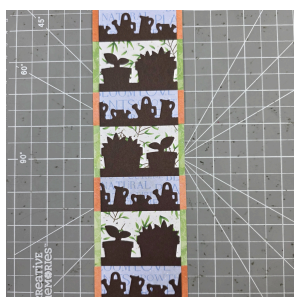
Flip all the segments over and use Tape Chips to adhere the BMC segments to the bottom of the Border Punch segments. One Border Punch segment will remain single.



Adhere the single Border Punch piece to the bottom of Strip B and then space the rest of the pieces above as shown.



Trim Accent Strip C into four 2-3/4" segments. Adhere them to Strip A to line up with the BMC strips as shown.



Adhere two strips together as shown. Then adhere this strip to the base border strip.

Repeat steps to create a second border if desired.

FINISHING THE LAYOUT

Cut four 12" strips of paper (or create border elements) no more than 1/2" tall and adhere 1/4" from the top and bottom of each page of the layout.

Adhere the borders 1/4" from left and right sides of the two page layout.

MATS & PHOTOS

(4) 3 x 4" mats; use with 2-1/2 x 3-1/2" photos
