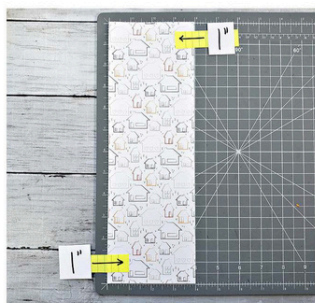


Angled Borders



A little angle goes a long ways! Two four-inch strips cut on a slight angle provide a perfect frame for this two page layout. Try experimenting with decorative blades to make the cuts to add more detail.



1. Start with a 4x12" piece of designer paper and mark 1" from top right and 1" from bottom left.



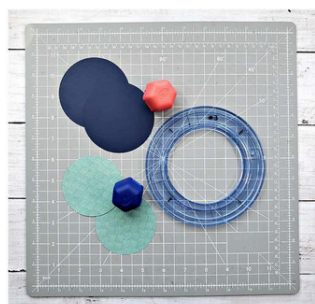
2. Trim on the angle.



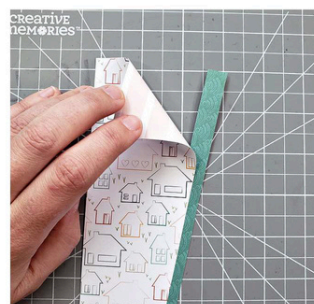
3. Repeat with second 4x12" paper to make second border set.



4. All the pieces you need to make the two border sets. You will use two chain borders - This example will layer the teal and blue Heart



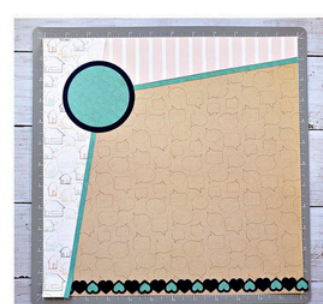
5. For the corner accent pieces, trim two cardstock circles with Circle #3, red blade, inside track. Trim two smaller circles with Circle #3, blue blade, inside track.



6. Attach the 1/2" accent strips to the back of the angled pieces. For the vertical pieces, leave unattached at the fat end.



7. Slide the horizontal pieces between the vertical piece and its accent strip as shown. Secure fat end of vertical piece with adhesive.



8. Assemble rest of pieces as shown. Complete other side in similar fashion but in opposite corner.
