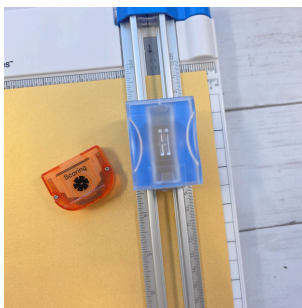


Sunlit Border Layout



SUPPLIES

- 2 sheets Bright White cardstock
- 1 sheet Gold Shimmer Paper
- Chasing the Sun Designer Paper Pack
- Chasing the Sun Mat Pack
- Scrap of Pumpkin Cardstock
- Sunlit Border Punch
- 12-inch Trimmer with straight and scoring blades
- Circle Punch (1-3/4")



STEP 1: Score the gold shimmer paper at 1-1/2". Fold along the score line.

Note: only do this technique with lighter weight shimmer paper or designer paper.



STEP 2: Insert the folded edge into the Sunlit Border Punch, placing the left edge at the left black hash mark and punch a 12" border.

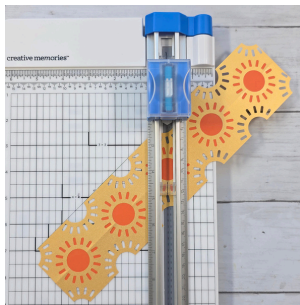


1-3/4" circles

STEP 3: Punch 5 circles from Pumpkin cardstock using the Circle Punch.



STEP 4: Use repo adhesive to adhere the orange circles to the back side of the Sunlit border, covering only the center full suns.



STEP 5: Cut the border in two on an angle by placing it on the 45° line of the 12-inch trimmer. Use the sight guides to find the center of the middle sun before cutting.

Repeat Steps 1-5 to create a second border.



STEP 6: Cut a sheet of tonal paper into (4) 3x12" strips. Adhere one strip 1/4" from the top and bottom of each base page.



STEP 7: Adhere the borders to the left page as shown. The right page mirrors the left.



STEP 8: Use repo adhesive to adhere the orange circles to the back side of the Sunlit border, covering only the center full suns.

Mats & Photos

- (3) 4 x 6" mats; use with 3-1/2 x 5-1/2" photos
- (1) 4" sq mat; use with 3-1/2" sq photo
- (2) 4-1/2 x 6-1/2" mats from the mat pack; use with 4 x 6" photos
