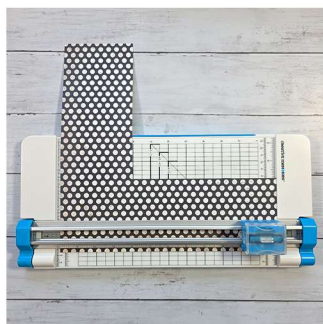




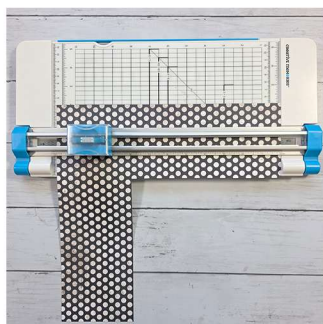
SUPPLIES

- L-Shaped* remnant of polka dot paper
- 12x12 base paper
- 13x13" Cutting Mat
- Ruler or T-Square
- 12-inch Trimmer
- Repositionable Adhesive

*L-shape is created by cutting a 8x8 square from the corner of a 12x12 piece of designer paper.



Step 1: Place the long edge of the paper in the trimmer at 1" and make a partial cut from 1" to 11". Rotate the paper to the other long edge and repeat.



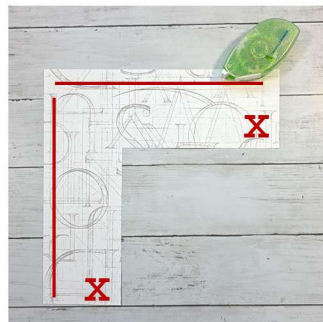
Step 2: Place the long edge of the paper in the trimmer at 2" and make a partial cut from 2" to 10". Rotate the paper to the other long edge and repeat.



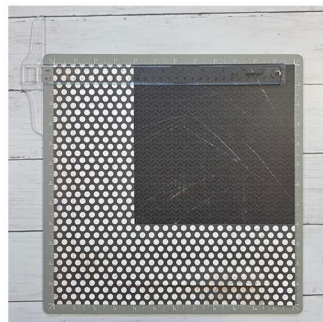
Step 3: Place the long edge of the paper in the trimmer at 3" and make a partial cut from 3" to 9". Rotate the paper to the other long edge and repeat.



The L shaped piece should still remain together, but have the corners cut like shown.



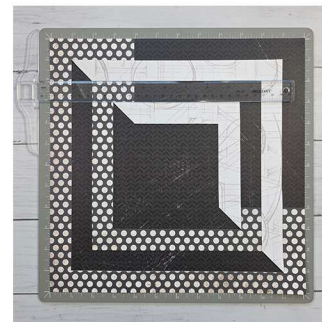
Step 4: Place repositionable adhesive on the long edges of the paper and on the ends (see red lines above.)



Step 5: Adhere the L piece to the background paper as shown.



Step 6: Fold back the cut corner as shown. Use a T-Square or ruler to help line the folded piece 1" from the outside edges.



Step 7: Fold back the last cut corner as shown. Use a T-Square or ruler to help line the folded piece 3" from the outside edges.
