



## SUPPLIES

- Chasing the Sun Designer Paper
- 1 Sheet Bright White Cardstock
- 1 Sheet Canary Cardstock
- Sunlit Border Punch
- 12-inch Trimmer with straight and scoring blades
- 13x13" Cutting Mat
- Chasing the Sun Stickers/Embellishments



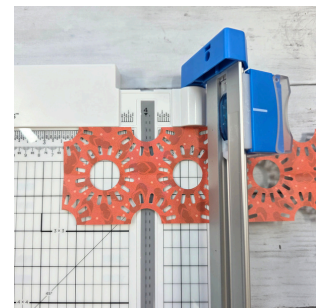
**STEP 1:** Score designer paper at 1-1/2" and fold along the score line.



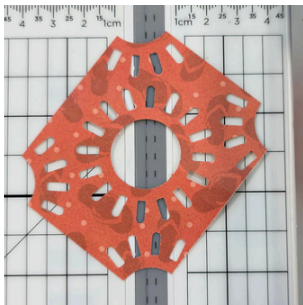
**STEP 2:** Place the folded edge in the Sunlit Border Punch, aligned with the black line on the front of the punch and punch a border.



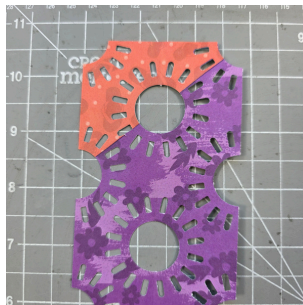
**STEP 3:** Repeat with a second tonal color or light weight shimmer paper.



**STEP 4:** Use the 12-in Trimmer to cut one of the borders into sections as shown.



**STEP 5:** Cut the segmented border pieces on the diagonal as shown.



**STEP 6:** Adhere the cut border pieces to the intact border to create a two-toned design.



**STEP 7:** Cut a 3-1/16" strip of Canary cardstock and use the Dandelion ink/brush to darken the edges if desired. Then adhere the border as shown.

### Finishing the layout

1. Cut a 12 x 1-1/2" strip of flip flop paper and adhere 1/4" from the top of the layout.
2. Cut a 12 x 3/4" strip of flip flop paper and adhere 1/4" from the bottom of the layout.
3. Cut a 12 x 9" piece of aqua paper and adhere in the middle of the page as shown.
4. Cut a 4 x 4" and 4 x 6" mat from Canary cardstock. Ink edges if desired. Pair with a 3-1/2" square and a 3-1/2 x 5-1/2" photo.
5. Add a variety mat with a 4 x 6" photo.
6. Add stickers and embellishments as desired.
