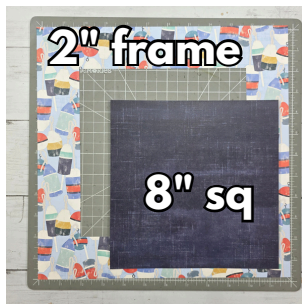


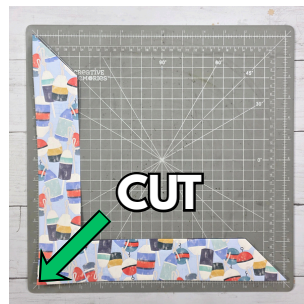


## SUPPLIES

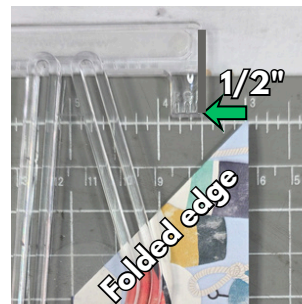
- 1 sheet designer paper
- 2 sheets cardstock or tonal paper for base
- Additional paper for mats
- CCS Border Cutting Tool (Zig Zag edge shown)
- CCS Blades (blue & red)



**STEP 1:** Trim a 2" frame from a sheet of designer paper. Save the 8" sq center for mats.

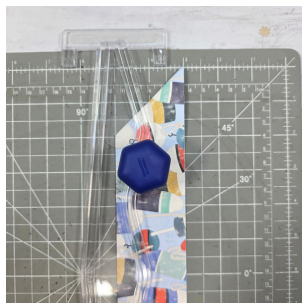


**STEP 2:** Fold the frame in half on the diagonal. Pay attention to the direction of the pattern. Cut the folded frame in half at the corner.

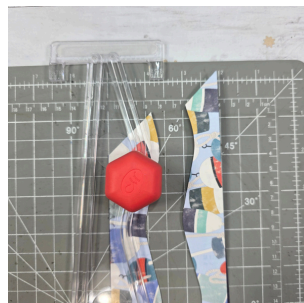


**STEP 3:** Place one of the folded pieces on the cutting mat with the long edge on the right.

**STEP 4:** Place the right edge of top right "foot" of the CCS Border Cutting Tool 1/2" to the left of the long edge of the paper.



**STEP 5:** Use the **BLUE BLADE** to cut along the track. **Do not move the template after cutting!**

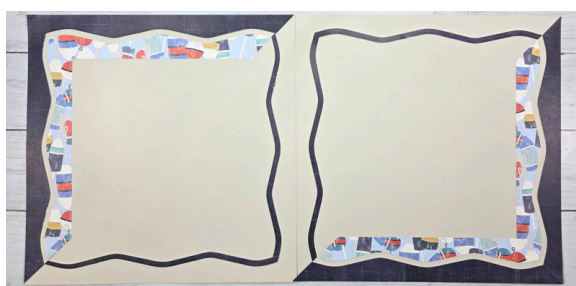


**STEP 6:** Use the **RED BLADE** to make a second cut.



**STEP 7:** Repeat steps 4-6 to cut the second folded piece of paper.

**STEP 8:** Unfold the cut border pieces and adhere to the base pages as desired.



## Finishing the layout

1. Cut the 8x8" square from step 1 into (4) 4" square mats.
2. Cut 4 additional 4" square mats. Adhere all mats to the layout as shown.
3. Crop 8 photos to 3-1/2" square and adhere to the mats.
