



Sample uses the Frost (2018) collection

Step 1: Use a piece of navy patterned paper for the base of this layout.

Step 2: Cut two 6" x 6" square pieces from the tree patterned paper. Cut two 6" x 6" square pieces from snowflake foiled patterned paper. Using the Garland Border Maker Cartridge or the BMC of your choice, punch the top edge of one tree patterned piece and the bottom edge of the second tree patterned piece. Punch one edge from each of the snowflake pieces as well. Adhere each square in a grid design on top of the navy base, with the garland edges aligned at the top and bottom, as shown.

Step 3: Cut a 12" x 2" strip of navy sweater patterned paper and adhere just above the center of the layout.

Step 4: Using one 4" x 6" and one 4" x 4" photo, cut mats for each using the white sweater patterned paper and the light blue sweater patterned paper. The dimensions are as follows: White (4-1/2" x 6-1/2" and 4-1/2" x 4-1/2"); Blue (4-3/4" x 6-3/4" and 4-3/4" x 4-3/4"). Mount the photos at an angle as shown.

Step 5: Punch three starburst shapes with navy patterned paper and three woodgrain foiled patterned paper. Apply Repositionable Adhesive to the shapes and mount the foil shapes offset over the navy shapes. Add to the layout as desired. Mount the insides of the foil shapes (reverse side) in the middle with Foam Squares to pop them up a bit.

Step 6: Cut a 3-1/2" x 1-1/4" and a 2-1/2" x 1-1/4" piece of navy patterned paper. Using scissors, cut a notch in the right-hand side of each piece. Mount "Winter" and "Fun" stickers to the pieces using Foam Squares and add to the layout. Add the "Tis the Season to Be Freezin'" sticker and journal as desired.
