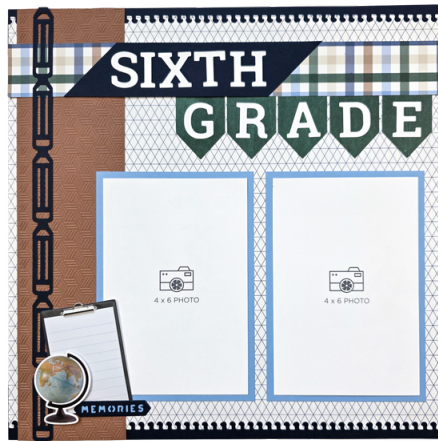




SUPPLIES

- School Years Paper Pack
- Carmel, Navy, Bright White and Songbird Blue Cardstock
- Notebook Edge BMC
- Pencil Chain BMC
- Hexagon Dash Embossing Folder
- Banner Flag Punch
- Block Serif ABC Dies

DIRECTIONS

STEP 1: Use the white triangle paper from the School Years paper pack and punch the top and bottom edge with the Notebook Edge BMC or other edge-style BMC. Alternatively, use a decorative blade on the 12" Rotary Trimmer to trim off ~1/4 to 1/2" from the top and bottom edges.

STEP 2: Trim two 12 x 2" strips of Navy Cardstock and layer behind the top and bottom edges of the base paper to re-establish a 12 x 12" page.

STEP 3: Cut a piece of Carmel Cardstock to 3 x 12" and use the Hexagon Dash Embossing Folder in the Die Cutting & Embossing Machine to add a dimensional detail to the piece. Adhere the piece to the layout, 1/4" from the left edge.

STEP 4: Cut a 12 x 1-1/2" piece of plaid paper and adhere 1" from the top edge of the layout. Spacing may need to be adjusted depending on which BMC you used to edge the paper.

STEP 5: Punch a 12" border from Navy Cardstock with the Pencil Chain BMC. Adhere to the left side of the embossed Carmel piece.

STEP 6: Cut two 4-3/8 x 6-3/8" mats from Songbird Blue cardstock. Adhere to the layout as shown and pair with 4 x 6" photos.

TITLE DETAIL

STEP 7: Use the Block Serif ABC die set + Bright White Cardstock to create the title letters. The second word will work best if it is no more than 6-7 letters long.

STEP 8: Cut a 1-1/2" strip of Navy Cardstock. With the strip turned horizontal, cut off the upper left corner of the strip at a 45-degree angle. Adhere the letters of the first word(s) of the title to the Navy strip and then cut off the lower right corner of the strip on a 45-degree angle. Adhere on top of the plaid strip of paper.

STEP 9: Use the Banner Flag Punch to create 3-7 banners (how many ever you need for your title) from green tonal paper. Adhere the a letter to each banner and then adhere the banners to the layout as shown.

STEP 10: Add embellishments as desired.
